<u>GUIDELINES FOR OUTSIDE RECESS</u>: Children are expected to wear warm clothing to protect them during cold weather when participating in recess or outside activities. _The decision to go outside or stay inside for recess is the decision of the administrator at individual schools.

The following are to be considered in determining if recess is to be held outside:

- _Temperature and humidity
- · Wind chill
- · _Heat index and air quality
- _Age of students
- Length of time outdoors
- · _Adequacy of the children's clothing
- _Condition of the playground
- _Falling precipitation (more than a sprinkle or mist)
- Thunder and lightning

Generally, it is assumed that students will be outside for recess when the temperature combined with the wind chill is not less than 20 degrees Fahrenheit or the heat index reading is less than 95.

Important: Children with certain health conditions may need special accommodations during extremely hot or cold weather. Parents of those children are to provide medical documentation and/or be consulted for determining if other arrangements are necessary. During hot weather, teachers should provide students a water break before and after recess. Additionally, any student who shows signs of heat exhaustion or overheating should be allowed a water break during the recess period.
