**LOBBYGUARD**: Our new security sign-in computer system is now activated. All visitors must bring a valid drivers' license to visit or volunteer in the school.

**PBIS PARENT INFORMATION MEETING:** Please join us for an informational meeting about the new Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) program that we have adopted at Manor Woods. We will meet at 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, October 23 in the Cafeteria. (Parents only, please! This meeting is not for children.)

**HALLOWEEN:** A letter will be sent home Thursday, 10/16, discussing the details of our Halloween celebration. Our families and special guests will be invited to join us for the parade that begins at 2:00 p.m. Please gather around the car loop to watch the parade. We ask that you leave the road and sidewalk area clear so that students have room to sit around the loop and to walk during the parade. If there is rain on that day, the parade will be cancelled. In order to maintain a safe and secure environment during the festivities, we will be unable to accommodate visitors within the building before or after the parade. Teams will coordinate volunteers to assist within the building during that time. These volunteers will be provided with a special identification tag that will be sent home prior to October 31. If you are bringing donations or costumes to the school, staff members will take items to the classroom areas for you. If your family does not wish to have your child(ren) participate in the Halloween parade and party, please notify Mrs. Summers, Principal's Secretary, so that alternative arrangements can be made for your child(ren) at school during the party/parade time.

**<u>PREVENT LOST ITEMS</u>**: Please label ALL of your child's belongings – backpack, lunch boxes, coats....**EVERYTHING!!** If your child does misplace an item, please check the Lost and Found, located just inside the front doors of the school.

**SCHOOL ARRIVAL PROCEDURE:** The official start time for our school day is 8:45 a.m. We will only provide supervision of students before school from 8:30 – 8:45 a.m. Because of supervision and security reasons, students and parents may not enter the building before 8:30 a.m. to wait in the lobby.

**LATE ARRIVALS:** When a child arrives late to school – **after the 8:45 a.m. bell has chimed** – a parent <u>MUST</u> accompany the child to the front office and sign him/her in on the Late Arrival Book. The digital clock in the front office determines the time, which is set according to Coordinated Universal Time.

**<u>CHANGE IN PICK-UP</u>**: Students often have after-school plans (sports, etc) that require a change in pick-up at dismissal time. A note should be sent to your child's teacher EVERY DAY that there is an alternate dismissal process. (This does not apply to PTA after school classes. You may send one note listing all classes for PTA.)

**<u>PARKING</u>**: Please **do not park** and leave your car unattended **at the red curb** – **THIS IS A FIRE LANE AND IS ILLEGAL**. Cars parked there may be ticketed. Also, unless you have a permit, **do not park in any handicap space**. We do have families with permits who must park in these spots; please be considerate of their needs.

**<u>BUS ASSIGNMENTS:</u>** Students must ride their assigned bus. Any bus change due to extenuating circumstances must be approved by Assistant Principal Nancy Richardson. Bus changes will be approved for **<u>emergency situations only.</u>**
