### BSAP Summer Institute (Grades K-9)

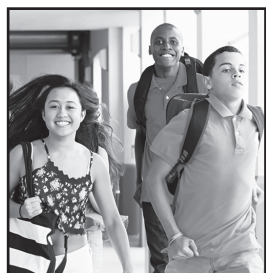
### Innovative Pathways (Grades 9-12)

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## Payments

## Financial Assistance

Financial assistance is available for all programs. Students currently receiving Free and Reduced-price Meals (FARMs) through HCPSS automatically qualify for 50 percent tuition reduction. Any family demonstrating financial hardship (families not receiving FARMs or families receiving FARMs with additional financial need) may apply for tuition reduction by submitting a Financial Assistance Request form with the required documentation.
