Redistricting Update

The November 21st vote by the Board of Education changed the attendance area for over 5,400 students across Howard County. Some students from St. John's Lane have been identified to attend Manor Woods Elementary School for the 2020-2021 school year. These families should have received an email from HCPSS with information regarding school placements and redistricting exemptions. While the process of determining who will be impacted is over, the planning for the transition has just begun. During the remainder of the school year, we will work to lessen the impact of the transition for all affected families by working closely with school system officials and the administration of St. John's Lane. We have scheduled a welcome/orientation at Manor Woods

Elementary on Thursday, January 23rd from 6:30-7:30 for the SJLES students moving to Manor Woods. (More information to follow.)

We know the anxiety around the transition is very real. We pledge to work alongside each family to negotiate the process. As we get further into the school year, we will be able to communicate directly with the specific families that need the information. More information on the Board's decision and attendance area adjustments is available on the HCPSS website. We will continue to keep our families informed of redistricting information via our newsletter and website. Updated School Closure

All Howard County Public School System (HCPSS) schools and offices will be closed on Tuesday, February 4, 2020, due to the special election to fill the 7th congressional district seat vacated following the passing of Rep. Elijah Cummings.

HCPSS schools and offices are typically closed on all election days as county school buildings are used as polling sites by the Howard County Board of Elections. Students and staff are not able to access school buildings for instruction while elections are underway.

As this closing was not originally listed on the HCPSS Calendar, we are making this announcement early to allow families to plan ahead for the closure. HCPSS has reached out to community partners who typically provide camps and other programs on non-school days to encourage them to provide similar opportunities on February 4. Additionally, our Office of Food and Nutrition Services is exploring the possibility of opening food sites where free lunches could be served to children under the age of 18.

The school system plans to apply to the Maryland State Department of Education for a waiver of the closing day.
