A Note From Mrs. DeBord and Mrs. Zinn

Dear Parents,

All Howard County Public School System students in kindergarten to grade 5 were screened to identify potential reading difficulties using the Amplify mClass with DIBELS 8th Edition assessment. The assessment will be administered again in the winter and spring.

Performance on the literacy skills assessed on the screener is an indicator of overall reading status and gives school staff additional information about whether a student is on track for grade-level reading success. Parents and guardians will receive a report containing their child's screening results via backpack on Friday, December 3rd.
