Kindergarten Registration

Information regarding an online registration date will be coming soon! Online registration must be completed before coming in person. Registration for students entering Kindergarten in Fall 2019 starts on Monday, March 11th and runs through Friday, March 15th from 9:15 a.m.-2:15 p.m. at Manor Woods Elementary. Kindergarten is mandatory in Maryland, so if your child turns 5 by September 1, 2019, you must register your child for the 2019-20 school year. Parents or guardians are to register students at the school serving the address where the child's parent or guardian resides. Information on neighborhood schools can be found through School Locator on the school system web site or by calling the Public Information Office at 410-313-6682.

The following documents are needed for registration:

Child's evidence of birth (birth certificate, birth registration or

baptismal certificate)

An authorized record of immunizations

Proof of residency in the form of a signed complete lease (including

landlord signatures) or deed

Current utility bill

Photo ID of parent/guardian

Proof of custody (if applicable)

LEARNING TOGETHER PROGRAM - PRE-KINDERGARTEN

The Waverly Regional Early Childhood Center (RECC) prekindergarten programs are making preparations for classes for the 2019-2020 school year. These classes include children with and without disabilities. The program's focus is helping all children develop communication, literacy, math, problem solving, motor, and social skills. Parents of children

who will be 3 or 4 years of age by September 1, 2019 may pick up an application packet in the school office beginning February 15, 2019.

All applications must be returned by Friday March 29, 2019. A limited number of openings are available for children without disabilities. Children are selected based upon screening information given on the application form and the "Ages and Stages Questionnaire," as well as observations of the child's participation in a playgroup. If necessary, a lottery process is conducted.
