Audition for Children's Chorus of Maryland Choir & Musicianship Classes!

Children's Chorus of Maryland has started auditions for the 2021-2022 Conservatory Season for children ages 5 ½ to 12. Young choristers attend **online, small-group, playful musicianship classes** Wednesdays & Saturdays, led by one of our Kodalytrained instructors, all of whom hold masters degrees in music education. Students also participate in a **live choir rehearsal each week on zoom with our Artistic Director**, in addition to **one on one meetings several times during the semester for individual help and feedback** on singing development and learning choir music.
