Kindergarten Registration

Online registration for the 2019-2020 school year is now open for new students. Online registration must be completed before coming in person. Parents can complete the registration process for students entering Kindergarten in Fall 2019 (finalize paperwork) starting on Monday, March 11th through Friday, March 15th from 9:15 a.m.-2:15 p.m. **7:30am-4:30pm Wednesday Only** at Manor Woods Elementary.

After beginning the registration process online, parents/guardians will need to contact their child's new school and schedule a registration appointment.

This final step confirms area residency, guardianship of the child and ensures that the registration process is completed correctly.

Kindergarten is mandatory in Maryland, so if your child turns 5 by September 1, 2019, you must register your child for the 2019-20 school year. Parents or guardians are to register

students at the school serving the address where the child's parent or guardian resides. Information on neighborhood schools can be found through <u>School Locator</u> on the <u>school</u> system web site or by calling the Public Information Office at 410-313-6682.

The following documents are needed for registration:

- Child's evidence of birth (birth certificate, birth registration or baptismal certificate)
- An authorized record of immunizations
- Proof of residency in the form of a signed complete lease (including landlord signatures) or deed
- Current utility bill
- Photo ID of parent/guardian
- Proof of custody (if applicable)

If you have any questions about Kindergarten Registration, please call Manor Woods Elementary at 410-313-7165.

**If you have a child currently attending an HCPSS PreK program, there is no need to re-register your student for Kindergarten.

**If you are a multi-family enrollment, please email our PPW, Kevin Lee at kevin_lee@hcpss.org for an appointment. Both host and guest must attend the appointment.

LEARNING TOGETHER PROGRAM - PRE-KINDERGARTEN

The Waverly Regional Early Childhood Center (RECC) prekindergarten programs are making preparations for classes for the 2019-2020 school year. These classes include children with and without disabilities. The program's focus is helping all children develop communication, literacy, math, problem solving, motor, and social skills. Parents of children who will be 3 or 4 years of age by September 1, 2019 may pick up an application packet in the school office beginning February 15, 2019.

All applications must be returned by Friday March 29, 2019. A limited number of openings are available for children without disabilities. Children are selected based upon screening information given on the application form and the "Ages and Stages Questionnaire," as well as observations of the child's participation in a playgroup. If necessary, a lottery process is conducted.
